The South Wales Metro is a proposed integration of heavy rail and development of light rail and bus-based public transport services and systems in South East Wales around the hub of Cardiff Central.

What is MUD?

MUD is an initiative that looks at sites identified as potential key Metro stations, exploring their history, character and function and how the Metro system might affect the future development of those areas.

On 24th September, small but diverse teams will be tasked with analysing the station sites and proposing ideas for improvement and integrating the new rail network into the local context.

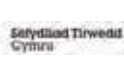
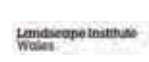
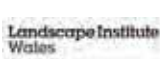
