Treforest

Glynatff

Travel directions to the university's campuses and facilities

Treforest and Glynatff

Both campuses are situated just 12 miles north of Cardiff. **By Road** - From the M4, exit at J32 and join the A470 north towards Merthyr Tydfil and Pontypridd. After about 6 miles, you will see signs for the A473 (Llantrisant) and the University of Glamorgan. **Treforest campus:** Take the first exit off the roundabout, across the bridge. Turn left, then stay left and follow the road for about 1/2 mile to reach the University. **Sat Nav:** CF37 1DL

Glynatff campus: Take the second exit off the roundabout and at the traffic lights, turn right on to Cemetery Road. The Gatehouse and Main Reception is on your right, before the mini roundabout. **Sat Nav:** Lower Glynatff - CF37 4BD; Upper Glynatff - CF37 4AT

By Train - A regular train service operates between Cardiff and Merthyr Tydfil, stopping at stations in Treforest and Pontypridd. **By Air** - Cardiff International Airport is 11 miles from Cardiff city centre and is serviced by regular bus and rail links.

The ATRIUM campus, Cardiff

The ATRIUM is in the centre of Cardiff and can be reached from J29, J32 or J33 of the M4, by following the signs for the city centre. A number of public car parks are nearby (rates apply). The ATRIUM is also close to all public transport links. For more information, see the detailed map overleaf.

Glamorgan Sport Park

Glamorgan Sport Park is a short distance from the Treforest and Glynatff campuses.

By Road - (From the M4) Exit the M4 at J32 and travel north on the A470 for 4 miles. Exit the A470 at the junction marked A4054 and take the 1st exit into Treforest Industrial Estate (A4054). You will see signs for Glamorgan Sport Park on your left, just before the A70 building. (From Merthyr Tydfil) Travel south on the A470 until you reach the junction marked A4054. Take the fourth exit off the roundabout into Treforest Industrial Estate (A4054). You will see signs for Glamorgan Sport Park on your left, just before the A70 building. **By Train** - A regular train service operates between Cardiff and Merthyr Tydfil, stopping at stations in Treforest Estate, Treforest and Pontypridd. **Sat Nav:** CF37 5UP

Getting to the ATRIUM campus, Cardiff

The ATRIUM campus is situated in Wales' lively capital city, Cardiff, close to the bustling city centre (a top 10 UK shopping destination) with a huge selection of high street and independent shops, restaurants and bars.

By Car: From West: Leave the M4 at J29 and travel along the A48(M) for about four miles. At the junction with the A4232 (Cardiff East / Docks) leave the A48(M) and stay in the left dedicated lane. Keep left (do not take the flyover) and turn right at the traffic lights on to Newport Road. Follow the road for another 2.5 miles into the city centre. Park in one of the public car parks indicated on the map below (there is no visitor parking available at the ATRIUM).

From North / East: Leave the M4 at J32 (A470) and follow the A470 into the city centre (map indicates recommended route). When you see the large white buildings of City Hall and Cathays Park (key 10) on your left, turn left on to Boulevard De Nantes and go straight on at the next lights. Follow the road as it bears right, and after the railway bridge turn right at the lights. Follow the road around (as indicated) and you will see ATRIUM on your right. Park in one of the public car parks indicated on the map below (there is no visitor parking available at ATRIUM).

By Train: The nearest mainline service is Cardiff Queen Street station (key 7).

Getting from Treforest to Glyntaff

Glyntaff is within easy reach of Treforest. Journey times are 5 minutes by car or bike and 10-15 minutes by foot.

Walking – Starting at the front of the University on Llantwit Road, walk down towards Park Street under the railway bridge and keep to the left hand side of the road. Continue to the end of the row of shops and cross over the junction where the road bears left up the hill (please take care crossing the road). Continue along the pavement for another 200m until you reach a pedestrian crossing on your right. Cross the two roads using the pedestrian crossings and bear right on to the footbridge over the river. Follow the pavement around to the left, underneath the flyover and take the first left up the hill. Use the pedestrian crossing to cross on to Cemetery Road. The Glyntaff campus is in front of you.

By car / bike – Starting on Llantwit Road, drive down Park Street and past the shops. On the one way system, keep right and turn right at the junction opposite Domino's Pizza. Get in the left lane and keep left as you cross the river. Go underneath the flyover and take the first left, up the hill. At the lights take a sharp turn right on to Cemetery Road. Glyntaff campus is in front of you.
