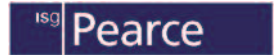

How to find us

**University of Wales,

From the West

Leave M4 at junction 28. Take A48 and follow signs to the docks (Usk Way).
At traffic lights, just before Newport Bridge, turn left onto Lower Dock Street.
At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto A4042 (Usk Way).
The University will be on your right.

From the East

Leave M4 at junction 24. Take A455 towards Newport Docks.
Continue forward and cross Newport Bridge.
At the traffic lights, turn right onto A4042 (Usk Way).
The University will be on your right.

From the North

Leave M4 at junction 26.
At the roundabout take A4051 signposted Newport.
At Harlequin roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A4042. Branch left, signposted Railway Station.
At Old Green Roundabout, take 2nd exit, then merge onto A4042, signposted City Centre, Docks.
Continue on A4042 (Usk Way).
The University Campus will be on your left.

There are a number of multi-storey car parks situated around the City Campus.
The two nearest are Emlin Street and Kingsway Centre.
