OVERVIEW

Bouygues UK delivered Zone 1 of Pentre Awel, the largest project ever undertaken by Carmarthenshire County Council, with significant investment from the Swansea Bay City Deal. The development was conceived as a flagship for environmental, social, and governance (ESG) excellence in construction. From the outset, the project set a benchmark for sustainability by achieving net zero in construction, while also creating meaningful community and educational opportunities. Bouygues' holistic approach integrated environmental stewardship, social value delivery, and strong governance practices to ensure the project generated lasting benefits for local people and future generations.

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS:

Net Zero in Construction

- Produced a Carbon Reduction and Management Plan at the outset.
- Deployed innovative digital tools such as Click LCA, Q-Flow, Smart Waste, and Gaia systems.
- Sourced sustainable materials, including 98% recycled reinforcement bars and a steel frame with 80% recycled content.

Social Value & Community Impact

- Delivered 5,205 weeks of training and employment against a target of 4,680.
- Generated £34m of verified social value, equal to 41.25% Social Local Economic Value (SLEV).
- Supported apprenticeships, STEM education, and meaningful engagement opportunities for young people.

Collaboration & Governance

- Produced a Carbon Reduction and Management Plan at the outset.
- Deployed innovative digital tools such as Click LCA, Q-Flow, Smart Waste, and Gaia systems.

SME EXCELLENCE:

Bouygues worked with SMEs that shared their sustainability goals, strengthening the local supply chain while advancing ESG objectives.

SMEs were engaged in sourcing sustainable materials, contributing innovation, and ensuring local economic benefits.

One highlight was sourcing reinforcement bars made of 98% recycled material and a steel frame containing 80% recycled content, achieved in partnership with SMEs willing to adopt circular economy practices. This collaboration not only reduced embodied carbon but also enhanced the knowledge base of local firms, positioning them as competitive players in sustainable construction.

LESSONS LEARNT AND FUTURE IMPACT

The Pentre Awel project became a model for embedding ESG at the heart of construction. Key lessons included:

- Early Stakeholder Engagement: Aligning ESG goals during pre-construction ensured the community's needs shaped delivery.
- Digital Innovation: Tools like Gaia and Smart Waste proved so successful that they will now become standard across Bouygues' UK projects.
- Capacity Building: Involving SMEs and upskilling the workforce created long-term regional resilience and competitiveness.

Looking forward, the project sets a precedent for Welsh and UK construction in achieving net zero and delivering tangible social value. It demonstrates how robust ESG integration not only benefits communities but also strengthens supply chains, enhances reputation, and drives industry-wide change.
